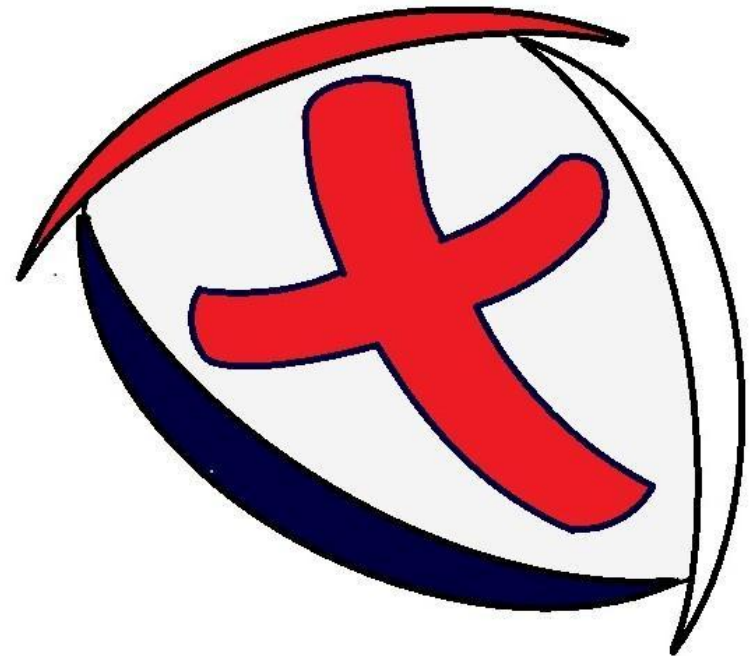

## **Arts and Crafts Competition**

### **Categories:**

**Crafts and 3D:** jewelry, baskets, beadwork, floral, wood, metal, paper mache, clay, dough, plaster, mobile, etc.

**Drawing & Painting:** pencil, chalk, marker, crayon, watercolor, oil, tempera, acrylic, fingerpaint, etc.

**Photography:** any printed photo student took him/herself

**Legos:** student's **original** Lego creations

All ages may compete, judging will be broken down as classes are separated at co-op: 2's, Pre-K, K, 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>, HS

**Students are limited to ONE (1) entry per category.**

### **Rules for Arts and Crafts competition:**

- ❖ All entries will be kept anonymous, NO NAMES MAY BE VISIBLE ON THE ARTWORK OR PROJECT.
- ❖ No Lego kits are allowed.

### **Participants will be judged on the following:**

- ❖ Title Card (title of artwork or type of craft)
  - example: "Paper Mache Pinata" or "Watercolor: Butterfly Wings")
- ❖ Neatness
- ❖ Presentation
  - Extra points awarded for 3D artwork if it is presented in a special way, for example in a basket, on a stand, etc

- Extra points awarded for flat artwork if it is presented in a special way, for example on a stand, or if it has been framed and/or matted
- Extra points awarded for Lego creations that are staged in some way
- ❖ Overall Impression
  - subjective evaluation of the judges that could take into account style, color, technique, difficulty level for age, wow factor, etc.
